<p>Special Health Issue COVID-19</p>	Decrease hospitalizations related to COVID-19	Support community initiatives, including increase percent of fully vaccinated individuals as recommended by CDC
<p>Substance Use and Recovery</p>	Decrease tobacco and vape use rates	Increase access to clinical education and training related to tobacco and vape cessation
<p>Lung Disease</p>	Increase awareness of substance use prevention and treatment resources	Promote education and training related to substance use (examples: harm reduction, naloxone, mental health first aid)
